O come all ye faithful 100C 220 vv 1,2,6 descant from sheet v6 (descant to be selected - Julie - otherwise vv 1,2,6 harmony

Good King Wenceslas 100C 102 All unison alternating, check harmony chorus v3 and v5 all. The holly and the ivy 100 C 328, note 1st altos take 2nd soprano part where divisi, 1st tenor/2nd tenor to handle "Sweet singing in the choir", final "sweet singing" check together, plus v 7 end.

Good King Wenceslas 100C 102 alt verses as written last verse unison only?

Nearly ready - still need work

We shall rehearse these on 28 Nov and decide whether we can sing both of them, just one, or neither.

O magnum mysterium Byrd 1st part only Christmas motets 8

We'll also be using our rehearsals on 28 Nov and 5 Dec, to make sure we're OK with all the hymns.
